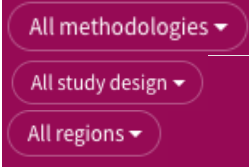
### Guide to use the Evidence Gap Map

#### Basic icons

You can use different features in the RTA Evidence Gap Map.

You can filter your search by **methodology**, **study design**, and **region**. The 3 methodology options are qualitative, quantitative, or mixed methods. Quantitative research relies on numerical data. Qualitative research relies on personal accounts or interviews. Mixed methods research considers a combination of quantitative and qualitative data. The 3 study design options are descriptive, relational, or causal. Descriptive research describes the characteristics of a population. Relational research explores the relationship between two or more variables. Causal research identifies the nature and extent of cause-and-effect relationships. The 11 region options follow the [ILO Subregion-Broad](#) groups.

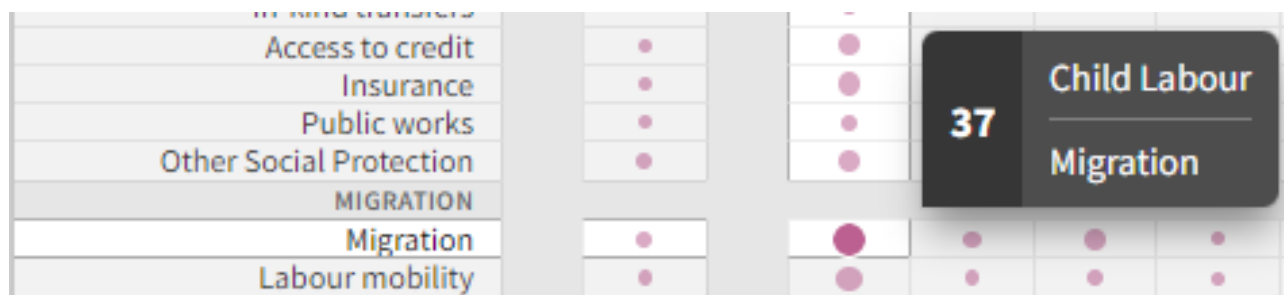
When the **Evidence** icon is white, it shows the Evidence Landscape. The bigger the bubble means more evidence. When the **Gap** icon is white, it shows the Evidence Gap Map. The darker the colour means the less evidence is available.

Press the **View full screen** icon to allow you to view the gap map in full screen mode. To reserve this action, press ESC.

The records are grouped by **factors** and **outcomes**. They are based on extensive consultations with an International Advisory Board (with researchers, employers' and workers' organizations, policymakers, civil societies, funding partners, etc.).
